## **CTE Honors:**

- Completes a Program of Study with a B or Better in Each Course (at least 2 courses in sequence *plus* a state-identified specific academic course requirement).
- Meet or Exceed Proficiency on a Performance-Based Assessment for the Corresponding Program of Study.
- Completes One of the Following Assessments for the Corresponding Program of Study:
  - Earn at least a 70% on each course assessment in a program of study (pathway core course and pathway cluster or concentration course), *or*
  - Earn a national industry skill certificate for the corresponding program of study. *or*
  - Meet proficiency on a State-Approved Dual Credit Articulated Program of Study assessment.
